MESSAGE FROM CANON MIKE

Those who were invited to the Coronation accepted this gesture with grace and honour. To receive an invitation, which most probably has been framed and is now on the sitting room wall reminds me of another invitation sent by another King to come and join in the Great Feast of the Mass.

There were very few who rejected the King and Queens invitation but there are those sadly in great numbers who say "NO" to come and sit at the table with the Lord, to share in this sacred meal and to find reassurance and acceptance as a member of God's Family. By our Baptism we are entitled to "Come to the Table" and Eat and Drink and share with others the Joys and Sorrows of being Church.
