WEEKLY MESSAGE

This Sunday we enter into the Fourth week of Advent leading to the Feast of Christmas on the very next day, December 25th. What a journey it's been for Mary and Joseph ! Two thousand years ago they travelled the 30miles or so from Nazareth to Bethlehem. Imagine how awful it must have been for Mary, heavily pregnant and riding on a donkey on totally unmade roads. The journey was physically demanding: treacherous tracks, fearful robbers, all in the heat of the mid-day sun. Thank God they did not give up, but having arrived at their destination, Bethlehem, they then found they were without shelter.

Great emphasis is placed upon Jesus and Mary, but the 'Quiet Man' Joseph, the dependable one was at the front guiding, encouraging, supporting, always being positive when all around were finding it hard to continue. We know so little about Joseph, other than he had great faith and trusted God implicitly.

So this Christmas let us with gratitude and deep appreciation continue our journey as did Mary, Joseph and Jesus and place all our Faith and Trust in the Lord, who will guide us, if only we place our hands in His. May the Peace of Our Lord Jesus Christ be with us all this Christmas.
