

MESSAGE FROM CANON MIKE

The quality of some TV programmes is shameful: full of dross and trash appealing to the 'me' culture . It's very hard to find any thing of educational value, anything of substance. I've never considered myself superior to the next person or tried to flaunt superior cultural values because I can sit in front of the TV screen and watch programmes considered to be "Low Brow" like any person here in Grangetown.

Many times we have seen "Talent Shows " where people of NO talent appear to be on an ego trip , trying to advance their career , instant recognition , fame and fortune over night . You might agree or disagree with me but another aspect of television is the multiplication of programmes on cooking , and buying and selling of houses and antiques . People looking for recognition , five minutes of fame , thrusting themselves into our living rooms. That's when , thanks to the invention of the TV control I switch channels or even switch off .

There are people we have all met who come across as arrogant , self satisfied , full of pomposity, who are lacking in a God given gift of Humility and Graciousness, which is freely offered sadly not often accepted . One of the Great People of the last century was Mahatma Gandhi who was asked if any thing he had read made a lasting impact upon him. To this he said "What the followers of Jesus call 'The Sermon on the Mount ' " the Beatitudes .How often I talk about the Jesus I know , love and follow as "Jesus of the Beatitudes" the antipathy of all that I've written about . His culture was one of Humility and Service. He showed the world , a new way of living , no longer the road of self satisfaction and pomposity but a WE not a ME culture .
