

WEEKLY MESSAGE

A date for your diary TUESDAY 3RD DECEMBER 5PM.

Last week we talked about reconnecting with loved ones and the Lord. This week's message is all about what we need to do when we have chosen to spoil a relationship. It might be that we have deliberately started a row, or retaliated in some way, or done something that we know is wrong. All these things niggle at us and if we are not careful will become a pattern. This is not what God wants for us. Making up with someone and being sorry is not easy and we might risk being rebuffed. It takes courage and often patience. When you want to say sorry to God it also takes courage, but there is no chance of you being rebuffed, no chance of the Lord turning you away. The Lord is always waiting for us to turn to Him and seek help when we are faced with challenge after challenge, situation after situation that may tempt us to make very bad choices indeed.

This week our older children begin their commitment to the preparation for Confirmation. Strangely their preparation will begin with their understanding of Baptism: what it means to be part of God's family. When we were all created we were given two very special gifts: the ability to develop a relationship with our Creator God and the ability to make choices. When you are Baptised, the darkness that entered your soul when Adam and Even made the wrong choice by choosing to go against God—Original sin, this is removed by the symbolism of the water and in its place is the light of the Lord, symbolised by the candle. This washing away of Original sin does not stop us making the wrong choices, but we have the Light of the Lord to guide us back to the right way.

Every day we rush around with endless 'to do' lists and there is little opportunity to just sit, be still and quieten our busy thoughts. This is also not easy to do. We have heard it said "Just place yourself in the presence of the Lord". He knows our very thoughts and He will give us calm if we give Him the opportunity to do so. A child once asked "How do you know that God is talking to you?" The answer? You have to stop talking and listen. You may not hear a voice from Heaven, but God will make Himself understood if you give Him a chance. You can have that chance on Tuesday 3rd December from 5pm when the Church will be open for you to give yourself a gift of peace. You can think about re-connecting with the Lord and maybe have a chat with one of the priests who will be available for personal conversations and confessions. Attached to this newsletter is guidance for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Reconciliation means making up, being sorry, putting things right. It may be that we have not availed ourselves of this chance for a very long time. Time to the Lord does not matter. He is just waiting. Waiting for you.
