MESSAGE FROM CANON MIKE

There is a difference between "What you want " and "What you need" We are very good at demanding rather than seeing what would be beneficial to oneself and the community . A few weeks ago we celebrated the Feast of Pentecost , the giving to the Church and the World the gift of the Holy Spirit . The Lord promised to send the Spirit to "Change the Face of the Earth"

Many of us have closed the doors and windows of our souls afraid that this Spirit will enter and change us from timid, wishy washy, part time followers of Jesus, to a people of commitment not afraid of proclaiming and living Gospel values in todays world. This Parish along with the whole Church need these gifts and this coming weekend a number of young adults have asked to be Confirmed. All of them heard the Lord calling them by their name and they have responded in opening the doors in welcome, knowing that what they receive will strengthen them in their relationship with the Lord .

These young Adults are not afraid of change, willing to reshape and transform their lives for the sake of the Church and of God's Faithful People.
