

MESSAGE

We live in such a confusing and complicated world. There are so many different forces pulling at us, so much happening that it is often difficult to make sense of things. Throughout Jesus' ministry, when He calls disciples, the first thing He does is make us part of a community called Church. This is a family. He calls us into this community because He knows that it is hard to be a Christian alone. We need each other. Being a follower of Jesus is too hard to do it alone: we need His help and presence and we need each other's help too.

We go in confidence (literally, with Faith) because Jesus has given us the authority which is only His to give. He puts us in charge of the decisions that we make .He has also entrusted us with His work. That is the mission of the Church: to do what He has commanded, in His name, with the trust and confidence that we are doing what He wants.

We are supposed to travel light when we go on this mission, unencumbered by all the doings of the world. Travelling light means that we trust in Jesus. Travelling light means we don't need to have a back up plan. We just need to follow His instructions. Trust in the Lord.

Not everyone will accept us, or our message, with open arms. There will be some who mock or who disagree and all we can do is entrust them to God. The Lord said on many occasions 'Do not let your hearts be troubled.... I am with you''. There will be occasions when we fall short of our mission, when things go awry. But let us not be discouraged. Remember the storm from a few weeks ago ? "Why fear? Reach our and I'll be there". The Lord's hands are ready to steady us today and always. We are part of His Family.
