### MESSAGE FROM CANON MIKE

Easter 2023 has arrived, new life, new hope, new beginnings. Darkness gives way to Light... Jesus 1, Devil 0.

This shows the power of following in the foot steps of Jesus who came into the world for this, to Die and to Rise.

Are we willing to follow the Jesus of the Beatitudes to lead a life of Service and Humility? If so we should have no fear of Death for we know and trust . **"For God's faithful people life is changed not ended "** 

You've heard me say so many times of "my father's Bus" coming for me, and on the front it says " Home" not "Magical Mystery Tour" People ask me "Mike, what's it like to Die ?" Even I can't answer that . . . "I don't know " I do know that when I'm placed to rest with my family and friends I must await a call to say my room has been prepared and so enter into the "Father's House where there are many rooms" The room and journey have been pre booked for everyone but sadly we've not been given a date . As the Lord said "I am the WAY the TRUTH and the LIFE "

We entered into a relationship with the Lord at our Baptism and over the years our love and understanding of Jesus and His teachings have blossomed. Where Jesus has gone we hope to follow for there is NO alternative. He has shown us the **WAY**, and if we recognise He speaks the **TRUTH** then we will all experience **LIFE** everlasting.

I'm no Theologian but as my many years as a Priest I've tried to lead people to the Truth , not fully understanding but trusting ...

"Lord where else can we go, for our hearts are restless till they rest with you, for you have that message of eternal life "

At present just words from a man who like all other men and women are unsure and sometimes fearful of the future, I look for meaning and reassurance like a child not knowing what lays ahead but learns to trust.
